<p><u>SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND MATHS (STM) SCHOLARSHIPS (SECONDARY)</u> Available to students intending on undertaking a Graduate Diploma of teaching or a Masters of teaching and learning and either their senior or junior level subject is science, maths or technology.</p>	<p>Course fees + \$10,000* 100 recipients</p>
<p><u>CAREER CHANGER SCHOLARSHIPS -TE REO MĀORI (SECONDARY OR WHAREKURA)</u> For people who have proficiency or fluency in te reo Māori, who have a depth of life and work experience, and who wish to change careers to teach Te Reo Māori as a subject in a secondary teacher or for a person who is wanting to teach a secondary subject at a wharekura where the language of instruction is te reo Māori. People who currently have a Limited Authority to Teach are eligible to apply.</p>	<p>Course fees + \$60,000* 30 Recipients</p>
<p><u>CAREER CHANGER SCHOLARSHIPS - MĀORI MEDIUM (PRIMARY)</u> Available to people who are proficient in te reo Māori, have a depth of life and work experience and wish to change careers to work as a teacher in or of te reo Māori in bilingual or total immersion settings at the primary level. Teacher Aides and people who have a Limited Authority to Teach are eligible to apply.</p>	<p>Course fees + \$90,000* 60 Recipients</p>
<p><u>TE REO MĀORI SCHOLARSHIPS (SECONDARY OR WHAREKURA)</u> For those who are in any year of study who have proficiency or fluency in te reo Māori and want to teach Te Reo Māori as a subject in a secondary school (Tipu Whakarito Te Reo Māori) or for a person who is wanting to teach a secondary subject in te reo Māori in Wharekura (Te Waka Whakarei).</p>	<p>Course fees + \$10,000* 60 Recipients</p>
<p><u>MĀORI MEDIUM SCHOLARSHIPS (PRIMARY)</u> For those who are in any year of study who have proficiency in te reo Māori and who want to be a teacher in or of te reo Māori in bilingual or total immersion settings at the primary level. Teacher Aides and people who have a Limited Authority to Teach are eligible to apply.</p>	<p>Course fees + \$10,000* 65 recipients</p>
<p><u>KUPE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR MĀORI AND PACIFIC HIGH ACHIEVERS (ECE, PRIMARY AND SECONDARY)</u> For those of Māori and/or Pacific descent who want to teach in early childhood education (ECE), primary or secondary schools. It is for undergraduate students who have already successfully completed at least one full year of their approved teaching qualification and received a B+ grade average, or for graduate students who are enrolled or enrolling in a one year Graduate Diploma/Masters of Teaching in 2019.</p>	<p>Course fees + \$15,000* + Formal mentoring 30 recipients</p>
<p><u>EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS - FOR PEOPLE WORKING WITH MĀORI AND PACIFIC COMMUNITIES</u> For people who have knowledge, understanding and experience working with either Māori or Pacific communities, with a focus on Māori or Pacific identity, language and culture who want to teach in the early childhood sector.</p>	<p>Course fees + \$10,000* 20 recipients</p>
<p><u>EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION TE REO MĀORI OR PACIFIC LANGUAGES SCHOLARSHIPS</u> For those who are fluent speakers of te reo Māori or a Pacific language and want to teach in the early childhood sector.</p>	<p>Course fees + \$10,000* 100 recipients</p>
