# 2018 Early Childhood Education Scholarships

## Māori and Pasifika Languages

Aotearoa needs great teachers. At the Ministry of Education we know that great teachers are not all the same – they have different backgrounds and life experiences. The Early Childhood Education Māori and Pasifika Language Scholarships acknowledge this diversity, and the energy and enthusiasm it can bring to teaching.

These scholarships are for people who have knowledge, understanding and experience of working with Māori or Pasifika communities and want to teach in the early childhood sector.

The scholarships provide financial assistance while you are studying towards a relevant teaching qualification.

The academic year for early childhood teaching qualifications has two intakes – one at the start of the calendar year and one that commences mid-year. This application form is for:

- students starting their study year in the first semester (beginning of the year). If you receive an ECE scholarship, your course fees will be paid from Semester 1, 2018; and

- students starting their study year in the second semester (mid-year). If you receive an ECE scholarship, your course fees will be paid from Semester 2, 2018.

This can be the start of your first or any subsequent year of study.


If you do not complete your study or bond period you will be held liable for the repayment of fees and allowance payments you received from your TeachNZ scholarship.
