Aotearoa needs great teachers. We know that great teachers are not all the same – they have different backgrounds and life experiences. The Te Reo Māori (Secondary or Wharekura) Scholarships acknowledge this diversity, and the energy and enthusiasm it can bring to teaching.

There are two types of scholarships available:

- **Tipu Whakarito Te Reo Māori** – for people wanting to teach te reo Māori as a subject in secondary schools.
- **Te Waka Whakareī** – for people wanting to teach a secondary subject in te reo Māori in wharekura.

These scholarships are available for people who are proficient in te reo Māori and who wish to work as secondary teachers. The scholarships provide financial assistance while you are studying towards a teaching qualification.



## 9. Whakapapa, reo, tikanga (To be completed in te reo Māori by applicant)

- ☐ proof of your highest qualification: either a certified copy of a work-related certificate or award, and/or an academic transcript for any study undertaken.
